

EHA Bilateral Collaborative Grant 2027

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Eligibility Checklist

The call for applications closes on September 1, 2026 at 16:00 CEST

Are you eligible?

Before starting your application, please make sure that you meet **ALL** of the following eligibility criteria.

EHA Membership

- ☐ Each PI must have an active EHA (2026) membership at the time of application deadline

Applicants

- ☐ Each PI must not have an [active EHA grant](#) at the time of application deadline
 - ☐ Both PIs must be independent researchers or group leaders
 - ☐ At least one PI must be a junior independent group leader, within five years of conducting independent research
- Note: Seniority requirement is not applicable if one of the PIs is from a [less-represented country](#)
- ☐ If a PI is a physician scientist, at least 50% of their time should be dedicated to lab research

Institutions

- ☐ The PIs must conduct their research in two different countries in [Europe](#)
 - ☐ Each affiliated institution must be an academic research center or proven equivalent
- Note: EHA grants are not suitable for grant agreements with national societies
- ☐ Each PI must have a full appointment in the affiliated institution

Budget

- ☐ PIs should not exceed the maximum (€320,000 for 2 years) allowed budget
 - ☐ The budget must be divided equally between the two PIs
- Note: no more than 70% of the budget can be allocated to one PI
- ☐ Your application will be ineligible if your budget does not include these mandatory costs:
 - EHA Congress attendance: up to €2,000 per year per PI
 - Final Audit report: up to €2,000 per PI
 - ☐ Your application will be ineligible if your budget contains overhead costs

Project

- ☐ Basic and translational lab-based research in hematology
- ☐ Your application will be ineligible if you do not use the provided project proposal template

Support Letters

- ☐ Each PI must have the support of the head of department and institution (4 letters to be submitted)
- ☐ Each head of department and institution must agree to the Bilateral Collaborative Grant Agreement in their letters, otherwise the application will be ineligible

Did you check all boxes? Then, you can proceed with your application.
