

EHA Research Mobility Grant 2026

Eligibility Checklist

EHA Executive Office

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Are you eligible?

Before starting your application, please make sure that you meet **ALL** of the following eligibility criteria.

EHA Membership

- ☐ You must have an active EHA (2026) membership at the time of application deadline

Applicant

- ☐ You must not have an [active EHA grant](#) at the time of application deadline
- ☐ You must hold at least one of the following academic qualifications:
 - PhD student
 - PhD graduation within 1 year of application deadline
 - MD in training (with residency and within one year of hematology accreditation)

Institution

- ☐ Both home and host institutions must be academic research centers or proven equivalents
Note: EHA grants are not suitable for grant agreements with national societies
- ☐ At least one of your institutions must be in [Europe](#)
- ☐ You must have a full appointment in your affiliated institution

Project Duration

- ☐ Maximum 3 months
- ☐ The project can be extended up to 6 months if justification is provided
- ☐ Projects longer than 6 months are ineligible

Budget

- ☐ You should not exceed the maximum allowed budget depending on the destination:
 - Up to € 7,500 for mobility within Europe
 - Up to € 10,000 for mobility outside Europe

Project

- ☐ Basic and translational lab-based research in hematology
- ☐ Your application will be ineligible if you do not send a project proposal (max 2 pages)

Support Letters

- ☐ You must have the support of your home/host mentors and the heads of departments (4 letters to be submitted)
- ☐ The heads of departments must agree to the EHA Research Grant Agreement in their letters, otherwise your application will be ineligible

Did you check all boxes? Then, you can proceed with your application.
