We are looking for a new committee member who meet the following criteria:

- Hematology researcher (fundamental/basic or translational research) specializing in *Thrombosis* and *Hemostasis*, as well as *Epigenetics*, *CLL*, and *Bioinformatics* with active research in *Cancer Biology* and *Oncology*;
- Established group leader;
- Successful in securing research funding;
- Enthusiastic about supporting hematology research in Europe;
- Mentoring experience (demonstrable track record as mentor).

Workload:

The majority of the workload for the committee is centered around the review and selection of grants winners as well as the review of progress reports:

A rough timeline of commitments for the selection of EHA grant application winners is below:

- September: Review of Kick-off Grant applications
- November: 3-hour call to select winners for the Kick-off Grants
- November-January: Preliminary review of Research Grant and Bilateral Collaborative Grant applications
- February: 3-hour video conference to shortlist applicants for external review
- Mid-April: Evaluation of external review feedback for 30+ applications
- April: 3-hour conference call to shortlist candidates for interviews
- Mid-May: 3-day attendance of the interview meeting at the EHA office in the Hague
- Throughout the year: Review of max. two simple Research Mobility Grant applications per month

Review Grantee Reports

- One interim report per month (on average)
- One final report per month (on average)

Appointment: for 3 years in the first instance.
