The overarching aim of the Committee is to further strengthen EHA's interactions with and relevance for the wider hematological research community by improving existing activities and developing new initiatives.

The EHA Research Committee coordinates, integrates and promotes research activities (basic, translational and clinical) across all EHA initiatives, including the Specialized Working Groups, Fellowship & Grants, the EHA-ASH Translational Research Training in Hematology, the Clinical Research Training in Hematology and the EHA-EMBL-EBI Computational Biology Training in Hematology. It oversees the respective committees, and also provides inputs to European Affairs, YoungEHA, the EHA Annual Congress, the EHA Journal HemaSphere and for Research projects with EHA participation.

To maintain and expand a broader representation of EHA membership, we are looking for a new Research Committee member who is:

- a high-profile researcher (fundamental/basic or translational research) and established group leader in hematology, with a specific expertise in pediatric hematology
- committed to play an active role in supporting and innovating hematology research in Europe
- enthusiastic to contribute to achieving the objectives of EHA
