- Able to contribute ideas, skills or tools that can augment YoungEHA's impact;
- Passionate about a transparent and inclusive hematology community;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills;
- Enthusiastic about teamwork and international collaboration;
- Willing to dedicate time and energy to initiate and manage projects.

Based on the association's commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion and the current composition of the committee, we especially encourage applications from fundamental researchers and those from countries not yet represented.*

### Workload:

- Meetings: Available to attend at least 75% of committee TCs (once every 2-3 months) and face-to-face meetings (2x/year, one in The Hague (Q1-2) and one at the EHA Annual Congress (June)).
- In addition, once you are a committee member, you may be asked to represent the YoungEHA committee on another EHA Committee.
- Offline: the committee members work on initiatives in subgroups for which we expect you to make time (approx. 3 to 6 hours a month).
