EHA accelerates the career development of researchers and clinicians in hematology through research funding, unique collaboration, and powerful mentoring opportunities







EHA Grants (2012 - 2024)





As of 2025, we have 5 different EHA Grant Categories






Extending the reach of EHA Grants

In 2024, for the first time, EHA reserved grants for researchers operating in less-represented countries defined as:

- Received less than 5 grants in the last 10 years
- GDP/Capita is below European average


EHA Research Grants

Basic or translational research

Support talented junior researchers in advancing their career

- □ Junior RG: Within 4 years from PhD/PharmD graduation
- Advanced RG: Between 4-8 years from PhD/PharmD graduation
- D Physician Scientist RG: MDs who want to perform research
- Topic-in Focus RG: in "Hemoglobinopathies" or "Precision Hematology" (in any of the categories)
- > 2 Grants earmarked for researchers in less-represented countries

2025: We received 98 eligible applications, of which 15 were from less-represented countries

EHA Innovation Grants

Support the creation of consortia and the generation of preliminary data to facilitate applying for larger funding

- □ High-quality clinical or translational research in hematology
- □ € 300,000 for 2 years
- □ At least 3 PIs from at least 3 different European countries, including at least 1 from a lessrepresented country
- □ Connection with one or more EHA Specialized Working Groups
- □ At least one of the PIs must be within 5 years of his/her first senior appointment









eha Apply for the EHA Mentorship Program

The EHA Mentorship program is a new, career-focused program that provides individual mentoring support for early and mid-career clinicians and researchers in hematology.

This is a free, twelve-month program in which up to 50 mentor-mentee pairs, based in Europe, meet at least four times (online). There is one physical meeting at the EHA Congress, facilitated and supported by EHA.
