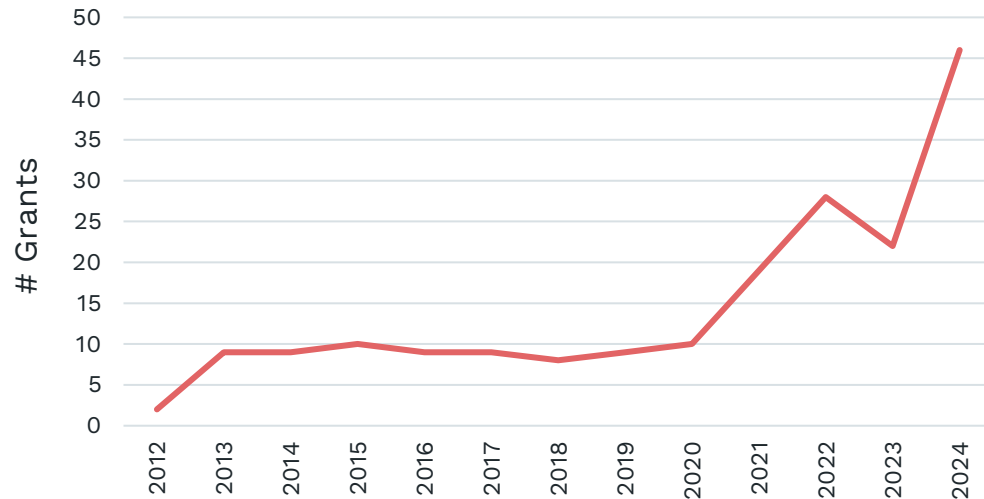

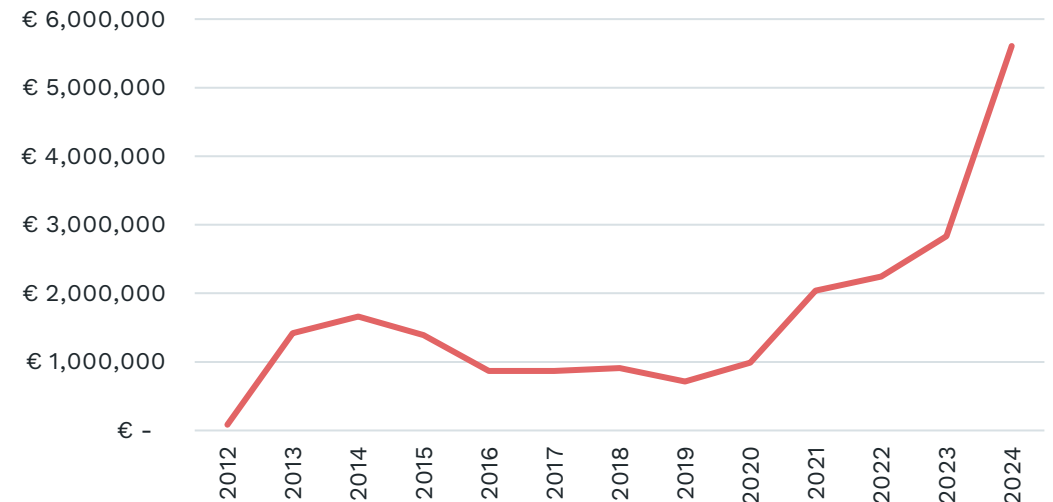

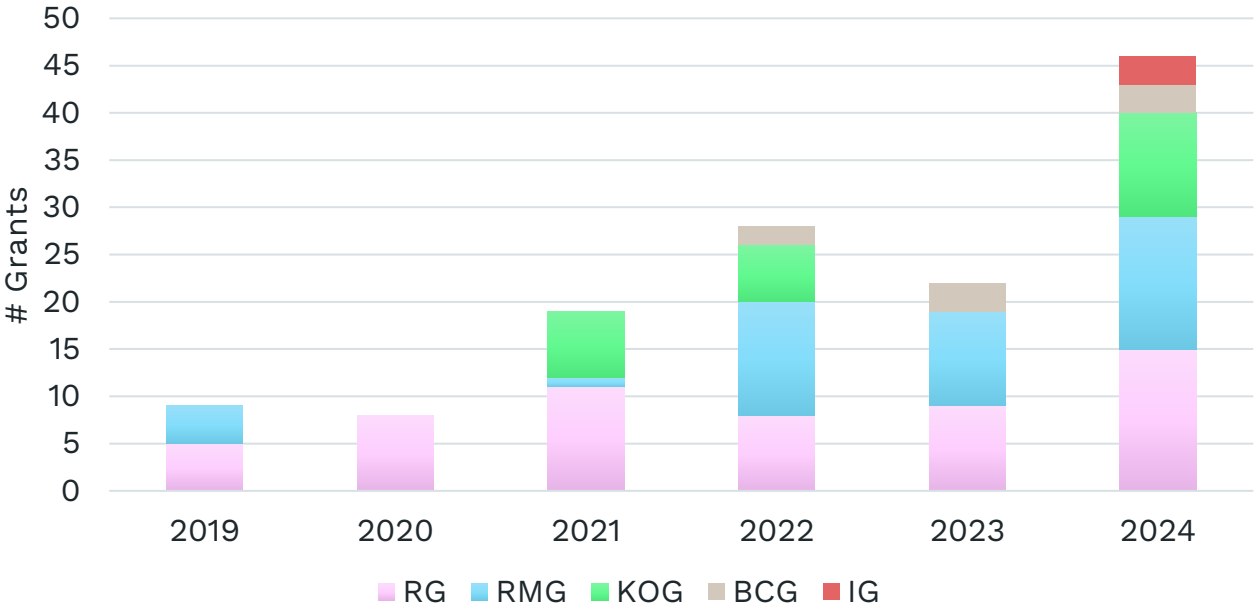

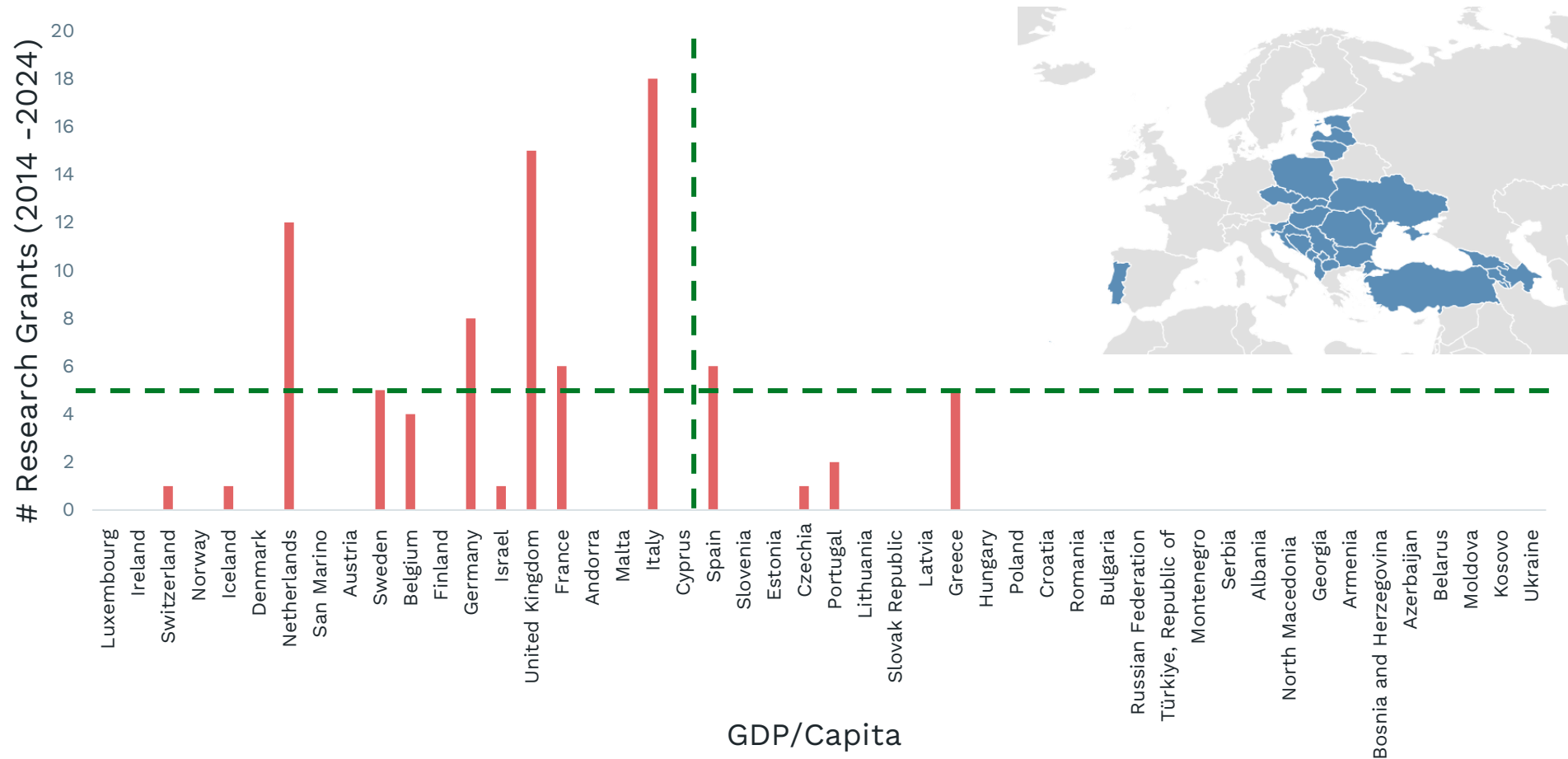
Grant Categories (2019 - 2024)



Extending the reach of EHA Grants

In 2024, for the first time, EHA reserved grants for researchers operating in less-represented countries defined as:

- Received less than 5 grants in the last 10 years
- GDP/Capita is below European average

Basic or translational research

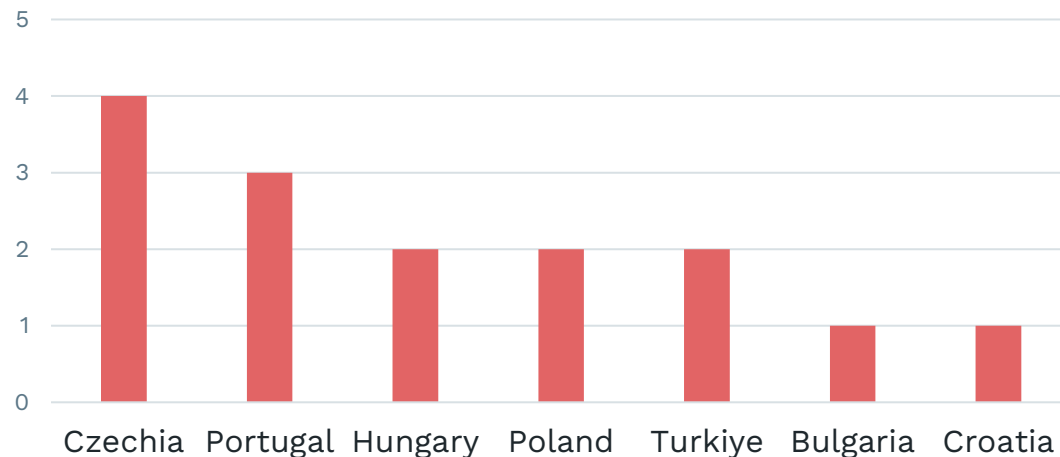
Support talented junior researchers in advancing their career

- ❑ *Junior RG: Within 4 years from PhD/PharmD graduation* € 150,000, 3 years
- ❑ *Advanced RG: Between 4-8 years from PhD/PharmD graduation* € 240,000, 3 years
- ❑ *Physician Scientist RG: MDs who want to perform research* € 240,000, 3 years

- *Topic-in Focus RG: in “Hemoglobinopathies” or “Precision Hematology”* (in any of the categories)

- *2 Grants earmarked for researchers in less-represented countries*

2025: We received 98 eligible applications, of which 15 were from less-represented countries

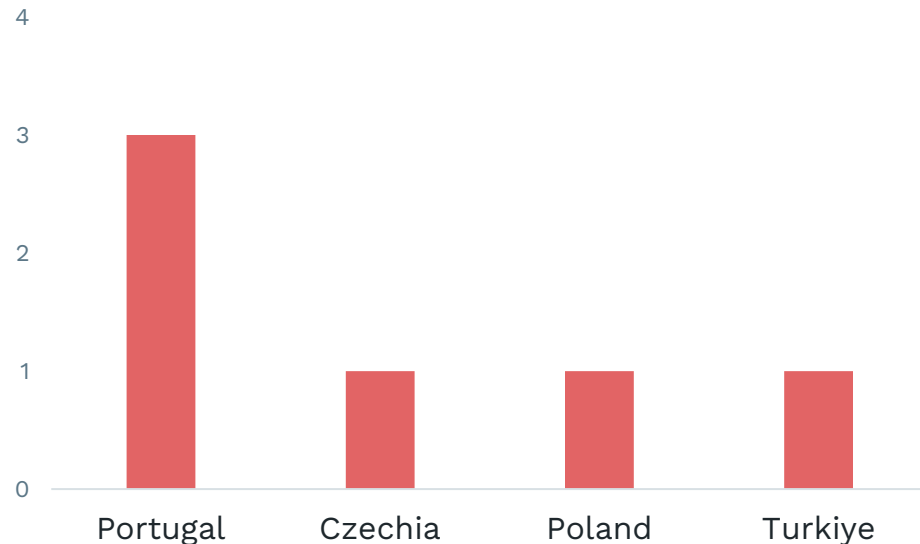

EHA Innovation Grants

Support the creation of consortia and the generation of preliminary data to facilitate applying for larger funding

- High-quality clinical or translational research in hematology*
- € 300,000 for 2 years*
- At least 3 PIs from at least 3 different European countries, including at least 1 from a less-represented country*
- Connection with one or more EHA Specialized Working Groups*
- At least one of the PIs must be within 5 years of his/her first senior appointment*



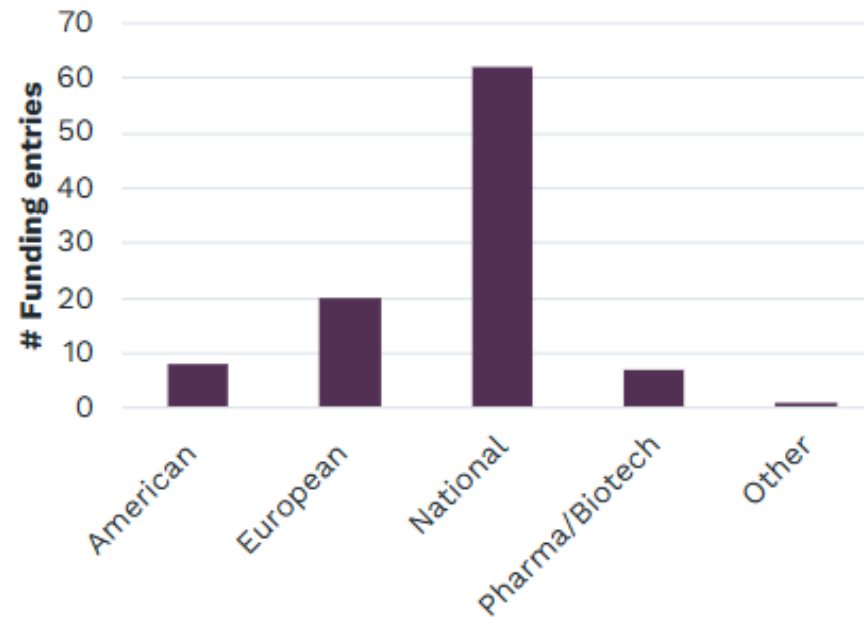
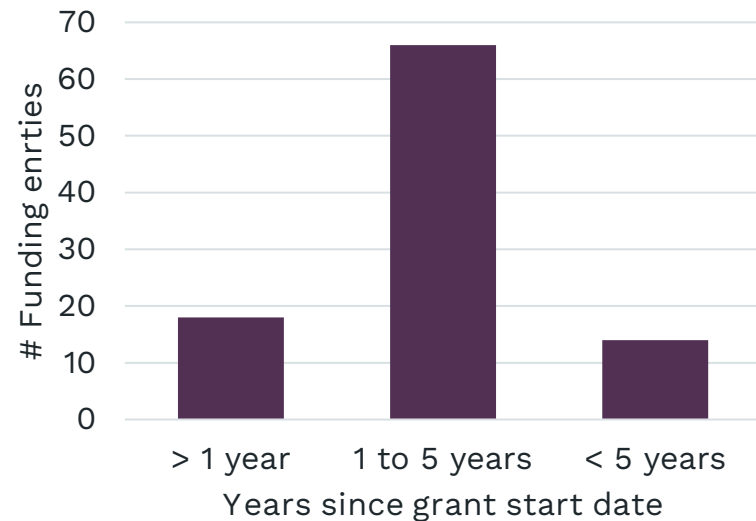

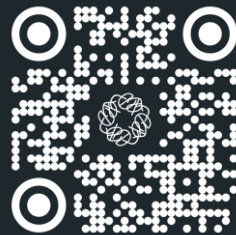


eha Apply for the EHA Mentorship Program

The EHA Mentorship program is a new, career-focused program that provides individual mentoring support for early and mid-career clinicians and researchers in hematology.

This is a free, twelve-month program in which up to 50 mentor-mentee pairs, based in Europe, meet at least four times (online). There is one physical meeting at the EHA Congress, facilitated and supported by EHA.

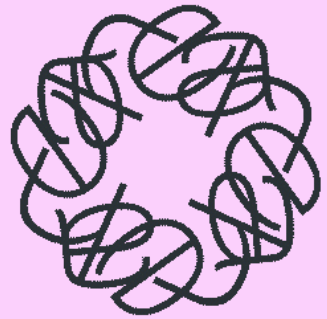
