“Recent Advances in the Pathogenesis and Treatment of Secondary Acute Myeloid Leukemia”

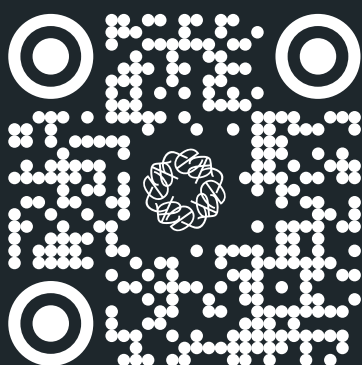
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## Why attend EHA-SWG?

The meeting will provide a thorough update on susceptibility factors to sAML, including germ-line and acquired molecular lesions, as well as the role of the bone marrow microenvironment.

In addition, clinically important aspects such as sAML following childhood malignancies, leukemogenic effects of drugs as well as prevention/surveillance strategies will be discussed. Finally, the meeting will also focus on special situations including sAML following gene therapy, CAR-T cell therapy, and AML of donor origin in the context of allogeneic stem cell transplantation.
